No Cop Academy: Fund Communities, Not Police! Mayor Rahm Emanuel is pushing a plan to spend \$95 million on a state of the art new training facility for Chicago police and first responders. We want to see that money spent on resources like schools, clinics, and housing instead. Chicago already spends \$1.5 billion on police every year (\$4 million per day). This plan is being praised as a development opportunity to help local residents around the proposed site, but when Rahm closed 50 schools in 2013, six were in this neighborhood.
